

GRIMES PUBLIC LIBRARY SEX OFFENDER POLICY

Pursuant to Chapter 692A.113 of the 2021 Code of Iowa, a sex offender who has been convicted of a sex offense against a minor is prohibited from being on or within 300 feet of library property without written permission from the Library Director and an affirmative vote by the Library Board of Trustees.

Registered sex offenders convicted of sex offenses against minors may register for a card directly with the Director, or designee and a system of delivery/return will be setup by the Director, or designee.

The issuance of a library card at any time is not permission to enter the library building.

The responsibility for compliance with this law rests with the offender. However, if Library staff has knowledge or receives information that a person who has been convicted of a sex offense against a minor is on library premises the Polk County Sheriff's Office will be contacted.
